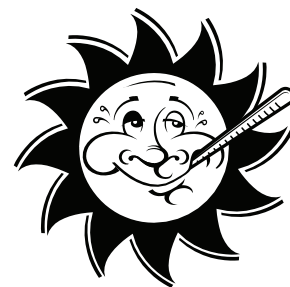
General Membership Meeting of February 18, 2021 MINUTES
